

What is Haiku?

Haiku Form:

- English-language haiku – arguably – has three lines, of 5-7-5 syllables respectively.
- Some of the critical aspects of haiku form:
 - Brevity – a maximum of 3 lines, 17 syllables
 - Juxtaposition -- two elements or lines of the haiku indirectly relate to a third.
 - Descriptiveness -- haiku describe, they don't prescribe or tell.
